## CATEGORY 7. INVEST IN COLLABORATIVE EFFORTS WITH COMMUNITY ORGANIZATIONS

## A. BEXAR COUNTY & BIBLIOTECH

The Leon Valley Public Library collaborated with Bexar County and BiblioTech to offer WIFI hotspots for checkout to members of the Leon Valley Public Library. Bexar County provided the hotspots through a grant agreement via the CARES Act, and BiblioTech helped us get everything started and ready to circulate. This check-out service offers internet access 24 hours a day, seven days a week during a time that it is greatly needed. #### B. HEROES TO THE RESCUE

The Leon Valley Public Library collaborated with our local police and fire/ems to put on a Heroes to the Rescue program when a regularly scheduled program fell through due to COVID-19. We had a firetruck, police car, fire and ems staff and police staff join us for our program. Outside of the City, we were joined by two heroes (Spiderman and Captain America) from the Singing Princess of San Antonio and two dancing robots from SAPS Entertainment who jumped in to help us with our last-minute programming switch thanks to funding from the Friends of the Leon Valley Public Library. ### C. DRIVE THROUGH PROGRAMMING

Due to COVID-19 restrictions many of our regular City events looked a bit different this year.

Hotspots are available for checkout on a first-come, first-serve basis for two weeks at a time. Your account must be in good standing to checkout a hotspot.
